Pack contents

1 x Bubble Tube Pump

 $1 \ x \ 12 ft \ hose - attached to pump. This end goes into the bubble tube to empty it$

 $1 \ x \ 5 ft$ hose – attached to pump. This end goes into a bucket for draining.

Getting Started

- 1. Remove pump and hose from packaging. Also, make sure you have a bucket before starting.
- 2. Switch power off to the bubble tube before proceeding. *Make sure you unplug the transformer from the 110v AC outlet before proceeding!*
- 3. Remove the lid from the top of the bubble tube.
- 4. Place the short piece of hose into the bucket.
- 5. Place the long piece of hose into your bubble tube, down to the bottom.
- 6. Put the pump on the floor (or bubble tube platform if you have one) and repeatedly press the top of the pump with your foot. The water will now be pumped from the bubble tube. Once the flow of water starts, it will continue to syphon on it's own. If the bucket gets full before the bubble tube is empty, lift the hose out of the water in the bubble tube to stop the flow of water.
- 7. Dump the bucket, and repeat steps 5 & 6 until the tube is empty.

Cleaning and Maintenance

• Make sure all water is removed from the pump and hose kit before storing.

Changing Bubble Tube Water

- All bubble tubes require the water in them changed every 4 6 weeks to slow the build-up of any bacteria.
- NOTE: Wrap a towel around the bubble tube column to prevent accidental dripping of water into the bubble tube base.
