Changing Bubble Tube Water

All bubble tubes require that the water in them be changed every 6-12 weeks to slow the build up of any bacteria. To change the water in an Experia LED Bubble Tube:

- 1. Remove the lid off the column.
- 2. Use a length of hose (4 yards minimum for a 80" column) to siphon the water out of the column into a bucket. Empty the bucket and repeat.

Note: We recommend wrapping a towel around the base of the clear column before removing the water. In the event of a spill, this offers a little extra protection against water entering the base.

Mounting the Mirrors

Fitting the Platform and Bubble Tube

- 1. Refer to the Bubble Tube Platform Product. Manual for complete instructions on the installation of the platform.
- 2. Start with the platform near the corner where it will be installed. Lay the bubble tube platform on its side. You will notice two connection points on the base of the bubble tube. One is for the transformer (larger bottom connector), and the other is for the control box (smaller top connector).
- 3. You will need to START putting the bubble tube up and through the platform. Once you have started doing this.....

- 4. Connect the cable from the transformer to the socket on the base of the tube
- 5. You will notice a black box on the underside of the bubble tube platform. Connect the cable from this to the control box socket on the base of the tube.
- 6. With one person holding the tube and the other holding the platform, slowly and carefully turn the bubble tube and the platform so that are both upright.
- 7. Move both units carefully to the final location. Once in place, try moving the bubble tube to ensure it is sitting flat to the ground. Using a level, ensure that the bubble tube is vertical.
- 8. Run the electrical cord out from under the platform in the corner. (Note: In the far corner of the platform there is a soft part of the underside for this cable to run where it will not be pinched. Refer to your platform manual.)
- 9. Install the bubble tube bracket approximately 3" from the top of the tube.
- 10. Now fill the bubble tube with water. (We recommend only using distilled water). If you spill any water, please ensure this is cleaned immediately. We recommend wrapping a towel around the tube when filling. Do not fill the tube to the top; stop filling when 3" from the top of the tube. Place the domed cap on top of the tube.
- 11. Plug the power cord into a nearby outlet. The bubble tube will now illuminate and begin to scroll through its many colors.

Please note: Use only the transformer supplied. Use of a different transformer may result in damage to the product and void the warranty.

Controlling the Colors

- 1. Simply press either the red, yellow, green or blue circle on the soft platform to change the tube to that color. Pressing the black circle will stop and start the bubbles.
- 2. If no switch is activated for 5 minutes the unit will revert to passive mode and the tube will begin changing colors automatically.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- The unit should be cleaned with a damp soft cloth. A non abrasive cleaning agent may be used for stubborn stains. Be sure no liquid enters the base of the unit.
- The unit has been designed for use by people with special needs, however this does NOT mean it is unbreakable. You must be sure the unit is not hit with anything and that no one pulls or pushes the unit.
